In preparation for Christmas, and especially for the worthy reception of the Eucharist, two priests will hear confessions:

December 17 – St. Gregory's Parish

December 18 – Holy Cross Parish

6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

The Holy Catholic Church wants us to have confession minimally once a year. Thus, in *Catechism of the Catholic Church* number 2042, we read, "The second precept [of the Church] ("You shall confess your sins at least once a year.") ensures preparation for the Eucharist by the reception of the sacrament of reconciliation, which continues Baptism's work of conversion and forgiveness". Refusing to confess at least once a year, we prevent ourselves from receiving the Eucharist.
