Excerpt from Pope Leo's Message:

He writes that the structural causes of poverty must be addressed and eliminated. "Helping the poor is a matter of justice before a question of charity," insists the Holy Father, quoting St Augustine, who observed: "You give bread to a hungry person; but it would be better if none were hungry, so that you would have no need to give it away."

Pope Leo urges us all to "offer new signs of hope" that will bear witness to Christian charity, which is the "is the greatest social commandment." He draws attention to the many "quiet signs of hope" - in care homes, community centres, soup kitchens, homeless shelters and low-income schools – that often go unnoticed.
